Manga is the Japanese form of comics/cartoons which covers a broad spectrum of genres from sports, science fiction and fantasy, horror, romance, sexuality and others. It is read by every age group in Japan. Manga covers issues from life. It has influenced comics and art all over the world. Many manga comics are illustrated in a dynamic use of lines for motion to give the characters the feeling of speed, exaggerated text used to emphasize emotion, and large eyes to give more expression. All to make the printed page more animated or anime.

Anime is the Japanese abbreviation for animation or animated cartoon. It uses many of the same motifs, themes, and characteristics as manga but in a cartoon. As the West, particularly the U.S., has influenced Japanese animation so has anime influenced the world's perspective of animation and what it can do to tell a story to all ages.

Eligibility:

This show is open to all artists – TVAA members and nonmembers.

Entry Fee:

Entry fee for members is \$5 per piece and \$10 per piece for nonmembers. Membership fee may be paid at in-take if desired.

Liability:

Entering this exhibition constitutes agreement to release the Texas Visual Arts Association, the TVAA Gallery, and the Plaza of the Americas from any liability for loss or damage to works of art in this exhibition. TVAA, the Gallery, or the Plaza of the Americas reserves the right to remove any work that is deemed objectionable for any reason.

Parking:

For delivery and pick up, you can park in the garage for \$1.50 for each twenty (20) minute interval (**vouchers are not provided for delivery or pick-up**). Metered parking is available on Pearl and Crockett Streets. Parking in lots on Crockett and San Jacinto are \$6.00. **DO NOT** park in the permit-only zones behind the building on Crockett Street. Full-day Gallery sitters may park free in the garage (entrance on San Jacinto – between Pearl and Crockett).

Terms and Conditions:

(All must be checked to show in the Gallery).

- I am entering original works of art: sculpture, watercolor, oil, acrylic, mixed media, collage, pastel, digital, photography, etc. that have not been shown previously in the TVAA Downtown Gallery.
- My artwork is properly framed with wire hangers.
- If glass is used to frame artwork, I am responsible for replacement if breakage occurs.
- Edges of gallery wrapped canvases are painted or clean - with no staples showing.
- I will schedule a sitting time for at least one (1) day Monday-Friday from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm, or for two (2) days for 3 hours, arrange for someone to sit for me, or pay the Gallery \$25 to find someone to sit for me during these hours. **Parking vouchers will be available only for full-day sitters.**
- I understand that appropriate dress is required when sitting in the Gallery.
- I agree to pick up my artwork on the pick-up date between 11:00 am and 1 pm. (If work is not picked up, there will be a charge of \$5 per piece a day unless other arrangements have been made with Gallery Director).
- I agree that my artwork may be photographed and/or filmed for public relations, educational, and/or other purposes.
- I understand that if awards are given during exhibitions, these awards are at the sole discretion of the curator/juror.
- I understand that sale of artwork placed in the TVAA Downtown Gallery is not guaranteed.
- If my artwork is sold, I agree to donate 15% of the price to TVAA and 10% to the Plaza of the Americas.
- I agree to pay my own sales tax on artwork that is sold.
